

Communicating With the Public

The Superintendent shall assure that the public is adequately informed about the condition and direction of the District.

The Superintendent will:

1. Provide for timely information, appropriate input, and strategic two-way dialogue between the District and the community that builds understanding and support for District efforts.
2. Prepare and publish, on behalf of the Board, quarterly progress reports to the public that includes the following items:
 - a. Data indicating student progress toward accomplishing the Board's **Results** policies;
 - b. Information about school district strategies, programs and operations intended to accomplish the Board's **Results** policies;
 - c. Revenues, expenditures and costs of major programs and a review of the District's financial condition.
3. Assure that parents are adequately informed about their children's progress.
4. Appropriately inform the affected areas of the community about proposed and current District capital projects.
